Uckfield Calendar 2011 – Competition Rules

Entering the Competition

1. The competition is open to residents within the Uckfield Parish Boundary only .
2. This is an amateur competition. Submissions by professional photographers will not be considered.
3. This competition is not open to Uckfield Town Council Councillors or employees, any person directly or indirectly involved with Uckfield Town Council or with the running of this competition or their direct family members.
4. All entries must be accompanied by an official entry form.

Competition categories

1. All entries must be of pictures taken in the Parish of Uckfield.
2. **Please note that no portraits of people will be accepted.**

Your photographs

- 1 No one may enter more than 2 photographs into the competition.
- 2 All photographs must be submitted in digital format (.jpg) and must be at least 300dpi and landscape only.
- 3 Photographs with text added to the image will not be accepted (date stamps automatically added by the camera will be accepted).
- 4 Prints will not be considered. Any prints that are submitted will not be returned.
- 5 Please ensure that you print off and keep a copy of your completed entry form.
- 6 All images should be accompanied by a brief caption.
- 7 You may submit up to two photographs to the competition, providing they are of a different subject. Multiple shots of the same subject will not be eligible for shortlisting and may not be accepted for the gallery.
- 8 It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that all the necessary permissions are obtained from any people featured in their photograph(s).
- 9 Anyone may submit photograph(s) to the competition, providing their submissions comply with the competition's Rules. However, there are limits to eligibility for the competition. See Entering the Competition for exclusions.
- 10 The closing date for entries is 31st July 2010. Winners will be notified by the end of August 2010 and the winning pictures will be used in the Council's 2011 Calendar.
- 11 Entrants under 16 must obtain written permission from a parent or guardian before entering. Please print and keep a copy of the entry form with all necessary signatures.
- 12 Uckfield Town Council reserves the right to reject submissions that do not conform to the Competition Rules; do not comply with UK and European legal requirements (copyright); or do not meet the competition's technical or editorial specifications.
- 13 You must provide Uckfield Town Council with your name, address and e-mail address if you wish to enter this competition. Uckfield Town Council will only ever use your personal details for the purposes of administering this competition, and will not publish them or provide them to anyone else without your permission.
- 14 Uckfield Town Council does not accept any responsibility for late or lost entries. Please note that proof of sending is not proof of receipt.
- 15 In entering the competition you agree to grant Uckfield Town Council a non-exclusive licence to publish and use your photographs for non-commercial purposes. Copyright will however remain with the photographer.
- 16 The prize(s) must be taken as stated and cannot be deferred. There will be no cash alternatives.
- 17 The decision of the judges is final in every situation and no correspondence will be entered into.
- 18 Uckfield Town Council reserves the right to cancel the competition (and any associated exhibition or event) at any stage, if deemed necessary in their opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of their control.
- 19 Entrants will be deemed to have understood the above rules and accepted them and agree to be bound to them when entering the competition.
- 20 These rules are governed by the laws of England and Wales.
- 21 All photographs entered into the competition must be suitable for publication on Uckfield Town Council's website and potentially in exhibitions and therefore should be suitable for a general audience.
- 22 The decision of the Council to accept or reject an entry is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 23 Pictures may be cropped Square for publishing purposes.

Judging and prizes

A panel comprised of the Town Mayor, Town Clerk and chairman of Uckfield Photographic Society will select the winning entries. The judges will be looking for originality, creativity, strong composition.

Prizes of book tokens to the value of £20 will be awarded to the twelve winners. Each entrant will be restricted to one prize only.

Winning entries will be used in Uckfield Town Council's 2011 Calendar and may also be used on the Council's website and in a display in the foyer at the Civic Centre, Uckfield.
