# 5.3. 2018/2019 Draft Budgets and New Initiatives

Members discussed the suggestions put forward under new initiatives which included (i) the erection of a shelter at Victoria Pleasure Ground and (ii) litter bins.

Although two locations for a shelter had been identified both could pose a problem, the possibility of gaining access to the pavilion roof and too close to the beacon. A further suggestion for a shelter to be placed adjacent to the car park could be too close nearby residents.

EL 97.01.18 Following further discussion it was **RESOLVED** to agree in principle to the provision of a shelter, subject to a suitable location being found, and that this idea be incorporated in the Council's 5-year Business Plan.

Members noted the draft 2018/2019 budgets.

6.1. To consider a request from the Uckfield Rotary Club to erect a memorial at Victoria Pleasure Ground.

Members discussed the request from the Rotary Club, however it was felt that there was insufficient information to make a decision. Concern was expressed as to whether a memorial of this type would, if approved, set a precedent and alternative suggestions were made, including a park bench or a memorial plaque on the pavilion wall. It was also suggested that as the Rotary Club had donated Elizabeth Gardens to the Town Council this could be an alternative area for some form of memorial. The Cricket Club are to be contacted to establish their views.

# **EL 98.01.18** It was **RESOLVED** to engage with the Rotary Club to obtain more details and other memorial ideas.
