I was invited to Uckfield Community Technology College's (UCTC) Mock Election Debate in May which was a fantastic exercise organised by the politics students. Local politicians were in attendance from the various parties and the students asked some excellent questions which created good healthy debate within the room. Will some of these students be our future politicians? I'm not sure, but they asked some challenging questions!

We have welcomed three nonvoting youth members onto the Town Council over the past couple of months to participate in our discussions about local issues. I'm often asked about matters within the town centre whilst carrying out civic duties. This not only means improved clarity in the footage captured but also means that as the partnership reviews its systems, the Town Council can ensure the equipment used remains in line with the latest technology. The Town Council has also agreed to replace the Town Clock as the existing one is unfortunately broken beyond repair.

I'm looking forward to the summer months – a full calendar of events and activities for Uckfield residents and visitors. A big thank you to all of the volunteers and community groups who make this happen! You make our town one to be proud of!

LAST MONTH IN YOUR COUNCIL

Each month Councillors take part in a number of committee and other meetings, including a Full Council meeting every two months. Here are some of the decisions which have been taken by those committees during April 2017:

The Environment and Leisure Committee reviewed a report on the ecology of Harlands Pond. On receiving concerns from local residents about the condition of the water, a survey was commissioned. The pond was recently designated as a Local Wildlife Site by Wealden District Council due to its significant toad population. It was recommended that the public be dissuaded from feeding wildlife within the pond.

Members also agreed to restore the Cardale Memorial and for it to remain at Victoria Pleasure Ground. However, if a more suitable location were to be found in the future it would be relocated. The General Purposes Committee considered a recommendation from the Environment and Leisure Committee which requested funds from the Town Council to support the running of a Saturday bus service between Forest Row and Heathfield. Despite one of the five parishes pulling out of the arrangement, members agreed to provide a financial contribution towards the service on the proviso that the other three parishes were still able to contribute.
