## ALLOTMENT CHARGES UPDATE



A review into allotment fees and charges was undertaken earlier in the year as the current structure, which has been in place since 2013, does not meet the costs involved in maintaining and administering them.

A working group was formed to research how other Parish and Town Councils structure their fees and to assess whether changes to the current system should be introduced. This research was used in deciding the new pricing structure.

The agreed changes will be introduced from 1 April 2022.
