The first phase is already underway which includes the repaving of the footpaths in Bell Farm Lane up to the roundabout, to match the paving in the High Street.

YOUR COUNCIL

This year sees elections take place for Uckfield Town Council and Wealden District Council on Thursday 4 May 2023.

Uckfield Town Council

The Town Council electoral boundaries divide the town into five Town Wards. There will be 15 Town Councillor seats and residents will be able to vote for their preferred candidates to fill the positions within their ward area.

Wealden District Council

On the same day Wealden District Council will be holding an election to enable householders to vote for suitable candidates to fill 45 District Councillor seats across the entire district, with five seats within Uckfield.

Want to become a Councillor?

In order to stand at the elections you must first obtain a nomination pack from the elections office at Wealden District Council, which will explain the nomination process. Relevant forms including a set of nomination papers will be in the pack for you to complete. Nomination packs for the elections will be available from March 2023. The Electoral Services team are currently accepting requests for packs. Requests should be sent by email to elections@ wealden.gov.uk with 'Nomination Packs'

in the subject field and should include the following information:

- Name of requester
- Address for packs to be sent to
- Whether district or parish nomination packs are required
- Number required of each type

NEW - Photo ID needed to vote

From 4 May 2023, voters in England will need to show photo ID to vote at polling stations. Visit https://www.electoralcommission.org.uk/i-am-a/voter/voter-id/accepted-forms-photo-id to find out what is accepted.

Voting in the election

If you are eligible to vote, you will receive a polling card through your door providing key information on your local polling station.

If you wish to find out if you are on the Electoral Register, request to receive a postal vote or view the Wealden District Council Ward boundaries, please visit www.wealden.gov.uk/voting-and-elections/.
