Species rich wildflower meadow:
EM2 General Purpose Meadow Mix,
EH1 Hedgerow Mix & EM10 Tussock

SUDS basins to incorporate species rich wildflower grassland providing localised biodiversity enhancements.

Children's play area to be incorporated within the public open space and surrounded by new planting that adds to the localised green infrastructure.

Proposed site access and associated visibility splays will require a section of the western boundary hedgerow to be removed. Replacement mixed native hedgerow planting is proposed set back behind the visibility splays and the proposed built form set back from London Road to ensure the character of the road corridor is maintained.

Ornamental Shrub Planting:
Hebe rakaiensis, Potentilla fruticosa 'Tangerine', Lonicera nitida, Genista lydia & Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote'



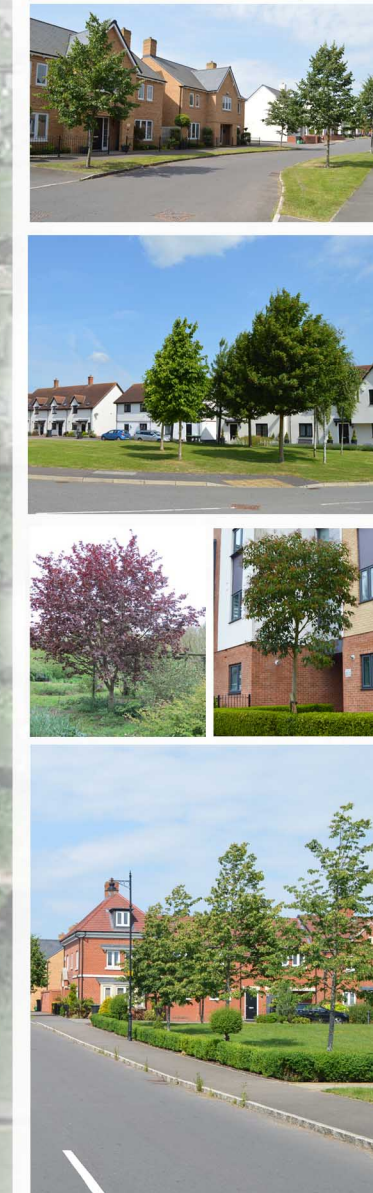
A 15m buffer to the Ancient Woodland will include the retention and enhancement of the existing grassland and incorporate a mosaic of native planting including species rich wildflower grassland, mixed native scrub and new native trees that will provide localised landscape and biodiversity enhancements.

Area of open space designated for use as a community garden to encourage health and wellbeing of individuals and the community through nature based activities.

Internally ornamental tree, hedge and shrub planting included to create a high quality landscape setting for the new properties and will include fruiting and flowering species offering wildlife interest.

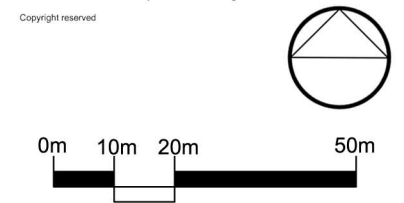
