# REMEMBRANCE SERVICES

There are three opportunities in Uckfield this month to pay your respects and remember those who have fallen during military service. This year, Remembrance Sunday falls on Sunday 10 November 2024.

### **Eugene Seghers Memorial**

At 10:30hrs on Sunday 10 November, a simple act of remembrance will take place at the memorial of Eugene Seghers, at the Highlands Inn, Uckfield. The late fighter pilot, who served with the Belgian Army, intercepted and deflected a German doodlebug, thereby sacrificing himself to save the people of Uckfield in July 1944.

### **Annual Parade and Service**

The annual Remembrance Service will take place at The Church of Holy Cross, Uckfield on Sunday 10 November 2024 at 15:00hrs.

Before the service, a parade will form in the 10-hour Luxfords car park from 14:15hrs and depart for the Church via Civic Approach, the High Street and Church Street at 14:35hrs. Members of the Uckfield Branch of the Royal British Legion invite ex-service personnel, local dignitaries, the local Uckfield Squadron of Air Cadets, and members of the Girl Guide and Scout Groups to join them on this parade. Members of the public are welcome to line the High Street to observe and pay their respects.

After the Church service and laying of the wreaths at the War Memorial, the parade



will reform and return to Luxfords Car Park via Church Street, the High Street and Library Way. The Mayor of Uckfield, Councillor Karen Bedwell, will then take the salute.

### **Armistice Day**

On Monday 11 November at 11:00hrs, there will be a short service in Belmont Lane adjacent to the War Memorial in Holy Cross Churchyard.

### Donations and poppy merchandise

The annual poppy appeal is well underway in Uckfield, with poppies available to purchase in most businesses, supermarkets, at the train station and in the Civic Centre.
